

From a financial statement standpoint, the CDD is very mature and debt-free, with a few depreciating infrastructure assets. The capital assets have decreased by \$450,000 as a result of the assets depreciating over their useful lives. Mr. Jowers anticipates that the CDD's assets will fully-depreciate in the next three to five years, assuming there are no new projects. He concluded that the CDD is consistent, year-over-year, in terms of the results of its operations. Overall, it was a clean audit.

Asked why \$900 accrued, Mr. Jowers stated it is a matter of the timing of when invoices are received versus when the CDD's financials are closed out by District Management.
